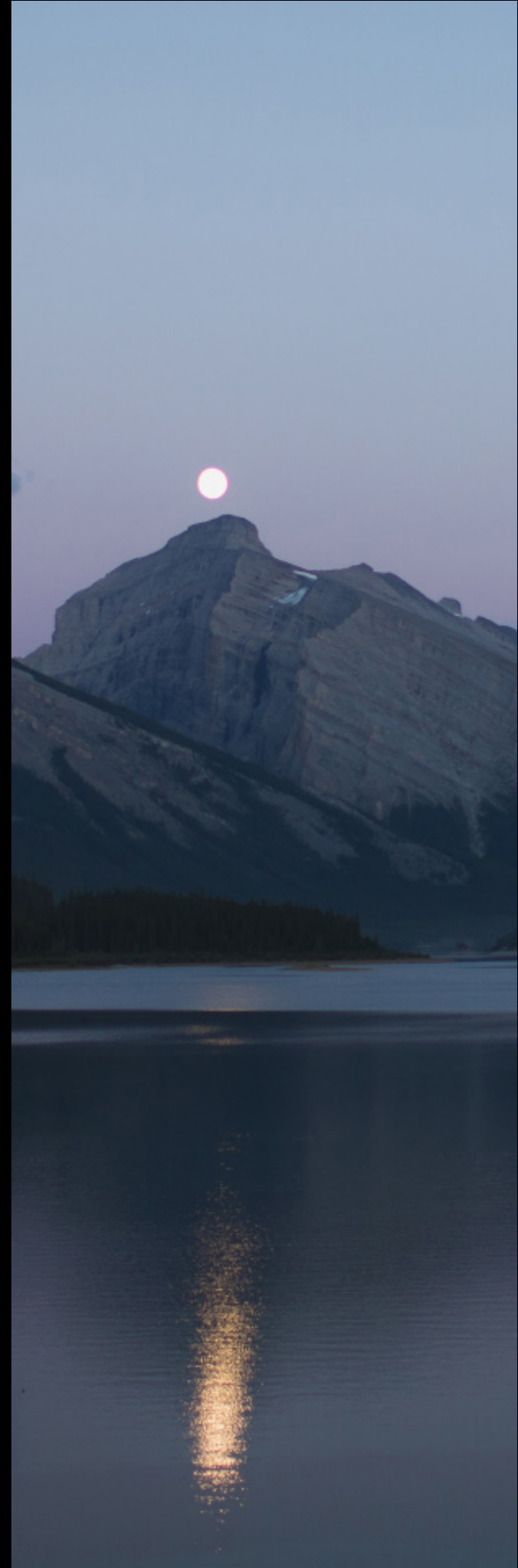

THE PATH TO THE THRONE:

1 SAMUEL 16

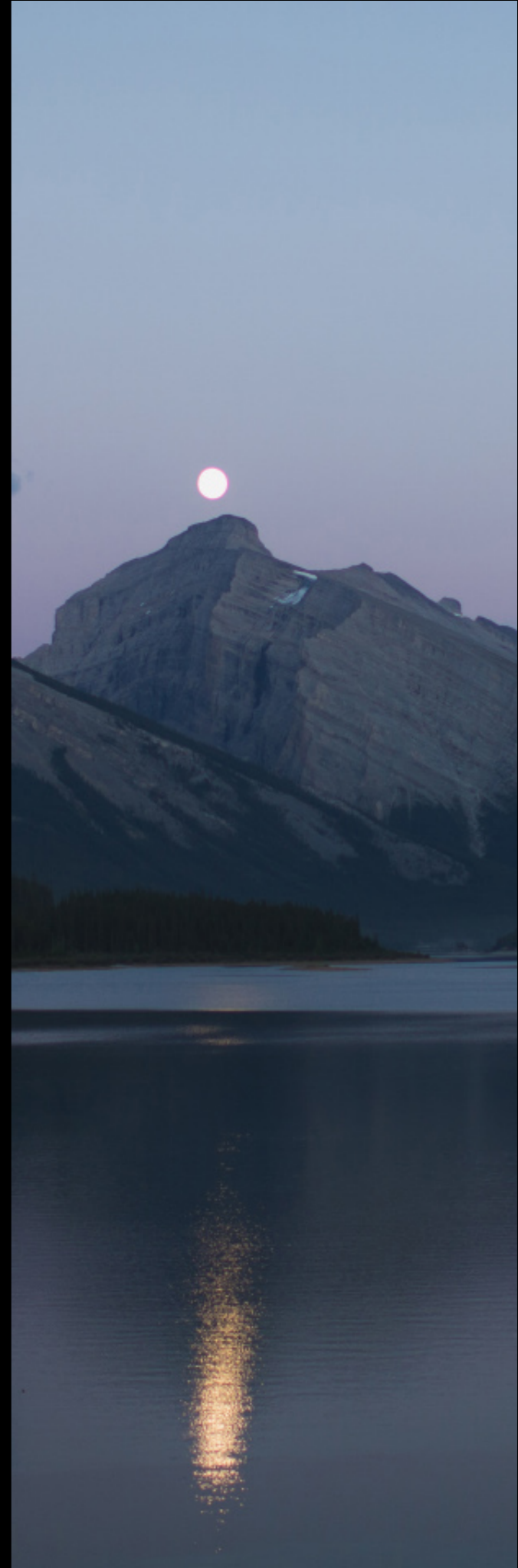
- Israel entered the Promised Land of Canaan under Joshua's leadership.
 - Joshua 24.13ff
- Following Joshua was the period of the judges of Israel.
 - Sin — Bondage — Repentance — Deliverance
- Israel cried out for a king — Saul was given the throne, followed by David.
 - 1 Samuel 8.5ff; 12.1; 15.26-28; 16.5ff



THE LIFE OF DAVID:

1 & 2 SAMUEL

- David was noted for being a man after God's own heart.
 - 1 Samuel 13.14
- In spite of the above, David had moments of keen failure.
 - All events surrounding Bathsheba - 2 Sam. 11ff
 - The Israelite census - 2 Sam. 24.1ff
- Through God's grace, David was forgiven and counted as righteous (Romans 4.5ff).



DAVID AND CHRIST: SEEING THE CONNECTION

- The promise concerning David's son.
 - 1 Chronicles 17.11-14
 - Hebrews 1.5 — Jesus was the promised son
- The promise concerning David's throne.
 - Psalm 89.1-4
 - Acts 2.30ff
 - A promise which endured the deepest valley in Israel's history (Jeremiah 22.30)
