













KEY MOMENTS IN THE OT: THE ABRAHAM STORY

THE ABRAHAM STORY: GENESIS 11-22

- Abram (Abraham) was called out of idolatry to follow God (Genesis 12.1-3; Joshua 24.2f).
- God's promises to Abraham (Gen. 12):
 - Blessings (2), Great name (2), Protection (3)
 - Land (1), Nation (2), Blessings for All Humanity (3)

THE ABRAHAM STORY: GENESIS 11-22

- Though he made a few bad choices, Abraham's life was generally one of belief and righteousness (15.6).
- Abraham and Sarah made a bad choice regarding Hagar and Ishmael (16.2ff).
- God reminds Abraham and Sarah that His promise of a nation will come through their future child (17.21).

THE ABRAHAM STORY: GENESIS 11-22

- Isaac is eventually born to Abraham and Sarah (21.3ff).
- Abraham is called to sacrifice Isaac as a sacrifice to God (22).
- God stops the sacrifice, praising Abraham's faith (22.8,12).
- Isaac is revealed as not only part of the Nation promise, but also the Seed promise (22.17-18).

WHAT IS GOD REVEALING? GENESIS 11-22

- The universal nature of His love.
 - Ur, Haran, "all the families of the earth"
- His unique ability to make man righteous through submission to Him (15.6).
- His trustworthiness as Promise-maker.
- The perfection of His timing.
- The Seed through whom the world would be blessed was coming (22.18).
 - Galatians 3.8,16
