CHOICES ARE IMPORTANT:

- ► My choice to believe or not believe.
 - ►John 8.24
- ► My choice to submit to Christ or not.
 - ► Hebrews 5.8-9
- ► My choice to endure or not.
 - ► 2 Timothy 4.7-8
- ► My choice to marry or not.
 - ► Proverbs 12.4; 31.11,28

- Is my choice between alternatives that are definitively good or bad?
 - ►I must choose what is good Romans 12.9
 - > Good is conforming to God, not the world 12.2
 - Sometimes my choice concerns issues about which God is neutral.
 - ► Example: circumcision (Galatians 5.6)
 - ► What choice am I to make in these situations?
 - What principles are given to us by God to help us make godly decisions?

So what are we talking about?



- Principles to consider when making decisions:
 - "Will this choice draw me closer to God?"
 - ► Closeness to God is important James 4.4-8
 - "Will this choice draw me closer to my brethren?"
 - ► This is what Jesus prayed for John 17.20f
 - ► Romans 12.10; Philippians 2.1ff
 - "Does this choice represent the priorities that God calls on me to have?"
 - My priorities must change when I come to Christ -Galatians 2.20; 3.26f

- ► Principles to consider when making decisions:
 - "What effect will this choice have on my family?"
 - Husbands/Fathers have a responsibility of spiritual leadership - Ephesians 5.28; 6.4
 - Family isn't a necessity to be saved; but when I have a family, that family is my responsibility - 1 Timothy 6.8; Matthew 6.25; 7.7-11
 - "Will this choice help me get home?"
 - I can't forget that I'm a pilgrim I'm not home yet -1 Peter 4.11f
